



- **Trafford Children's First Response Team** - Front Door multi-agency team for families to request support and agencies to refer children who they have concerns about – triaging referrals and completing child and family assessments if needed.
- **Neighbourhood Family Support Teams (North, South, Central and West)** - supporting children who are on Child in Need plans, Child Protection Plans, Public Law Outline and the initial stages of proceedings.
- **Complex Needs** - working closely with partners in Health and the SEND Team to ensure that children with complex needs receive the support they need in an appropriate and well-coordinated way.
- **Permanence** - supporting children who will be in care on a long-term or permanent basis.
- **Family Placement – Fostering, SGO's and Adoption**, recruiting, assessing and supporting our Foster Carers, supporting Special Guardianship Orders and working with the Regional Adoption Agency to ensure the right children are identified for adoption and the right families found.
- **Aftercare** – supporting our Care Leavers to help them move to independence in a positive and constructive way.
- **Intensive Family Support** - working in partnership to support families with needs who do not meet the threshold for social care intervention, including provision at Early Help Hubs and Place Based Integration. **Youth Engagement Service** (Youth Justice, Talkshop, StreetTalk and Connexions).
- **Independent Reviewing Officers, Children's Rights, and Strategic Safeguarding Partnership.**
- **Quality Assurance/Audit Team and Principle Social Worker.**
