Get BorrowBox Library via the app or the Trafford website

Browsing for eBooks and eAudio


You can browse books in borrowbox just like you would in the library. Click the eBooks or eAudiobooks icon and you can choose a category to brows through viewing books covers.


Sign in to the app or website

When the app first starts type in **Trafford Libraries**. You will then need to sign in with your library card number and pin (if your card number begins with TRP don't include this).



Navigating the site

Use the navigation buttons to find the books you want and check which books you have already read. On the app these buttons are at the bottom of the app and on the website they are at the top



Borrow items

Once you've found what you are looking for just tap borrow and you can download the item onto your device. You then have access to your book for the next 3 weeks without having to go online.



Search for eBooks and eAudio



Its easy to find the books you want. You can click the magnifying glass and type in the name of a book, author or genre to find what you are looking for.
