

**BOROUGH OF TRAFFORD (CENTRAL WAY, ALTRINCHAM)  
(PROHIBITION OF ENTRY) ORDER 2016**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Trafford Borough Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 1, 2 and 5 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering the following length of road in the direction stated:-

**Prohibition of Entry**

Central Way, Altrincham – at a point 70 metres southwest of its junction with Shaws Road  
– for vehicles travelling in a northerly direction only.

## **STATEMENT OF REASONS**

It is proposed to introduce a permanent Restricted Parking Zone on Shaws Road, part of Central Way and part of Cross Street.

These proposals, together with the Experimental Prohibition of Driving Order that is being introduced on lengths of Greenwood Street, Shaws Road and Central Way, Altrincham, necessitate the revocation of the existing One Way traffic regulation Orders covering Central Way and the creation of a new traffic regulation order to introduce a 'point no entry' (or false one way street). The proposals necessitate the relocation of the no entry signs on Central Way. These proposals will facilitate access into the area when the Experimental Prohibition of Driving Order is in force.
