STATEMENT OF REASONS

The Council has received a request from a disabled resident of Harcourt Street, Gorse Hill, Stretford, who is a blue badge holder, for consideration to be given to the provision of a disabled persons' permit parking space close to their property.

Harcourt Street is a residential street within the Gorse Hill area of Stretford and is fronted by terraced properties. Demand for on-street parking, particularly in the evenings and at weekends, means that the available space is at a premium. Harcourt Street is located within the the Gorse Hill 'Match-day' Residents' Parking Scheme and, as such, will require an amendment to the Traffic Order, if a disabled permit parking space is to be introduced at this location.

The disabled parking spaces within this area are designated Permit C and are operative on a 24-hour basis. The permits issued to the disabled residents differ to those valid for daytime restrictions although holders of C permits are also allowed to park in areas where 'match-day' restrictions apply.

In view of the demand for on-street parking in this area, it is considered that the applicant would benefit from the introduction of disabled permit parking space that would allow him to park directly outside his home.

It is proposed therefore, to amend the Schedule to the Borough of Trafford (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Provision of Parking) Order 2001, as amended, so as to introduce a Permit C parking space, at this location.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

A number of complaints have been received from residents regarding the inconsiderate parking of vehicles on Moorside Road at its junction with Roseneath Road, Urmston, resulting in the reduction of visibility.

Inconsiderate parking in the above area is prejudicing refuse collection and road safety. It is proposed to introduce 'At Any Time' parking restrictions.
