

**BOROUGH OF TRAFFORD (OFF-STREET CAR PARKS) ORDER 2001  
(AMENDMENT NO 9) ORDER 2020**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Trafford Borough Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to amend the Borough of Trafford (Off Street Car Parks) Order 2001 (the “2001 Order”) as follows:

1. By the addition of the car park specified in Schedule 1A to this Order to Schedule 3 (Free Car Parks) to the “2001 Order”;
2. By the addition of the car park specified in Schedule 1B to this Order to Schedule 4 (Charged Car Parks Accepting Either Pay & Display or Cashless/Ticketless Payment Transactions) to the “2001 Order”;
3. By the removal of the car parks specified in Schedule 2A to this Order from Schedule 3 (Free Car Parks) to the “2001 Order”;
4. By the addition of the car parks specified in Schedule 1C to this Order to Schedule 4 (Charged Car Parks Accepting Either Pay & Display or Cashless/Ticketless Payment Transactions) to the “2001 Order”;
5. By the removal of the car parks specified in Schedule 2B to this Order from Schedule 6 (Free Car Parks with Electric Vehicle Parking Spaces) to the “2001 Order”;
6. By the addition of the car parks specified in Schedule 1D to this Order to Schedule 4A (Charged Car Parks Accepting Either Pay & Display or Cashless/Ticketless Payment Transactions with Electric Vehicle Parking Spaces) to the “2001 Order”;
7. Article 7(2) to the “2001 Order” is hereby amended to remove the wording “Save as provided in Article 3(4)(c) below” and to insert the wording “Save as provided in Article 7(5)(c) below”.

## **STATEMENT OF REASONS**

The visitor car park for Trafford Town Hall is currently unrestricted but has attracted a number of public complaints regarding its misuse. To try to ensure that further complaints of vehicles being blocked in etc. be avoided it is proposed that a 3 hour maximum stay for customers and visitors accessing the Town Hall, with return prohibited for 12 hours, be implemented to help maximise available parking during times/days the building is open. It is proposed that outside these times/days, the car park will be closed.

A further proposal is to introduce a parking charge at the Greenbank Road car park, Ashton on Mersey, Sale which is currently free all day:

The proposal is for up to 2 hours free parking; over 2 hours £1, - charge applies Monday to Saturday, 8am to 6pm.

The Council has provided on-going financial support, since 2009, to ensure that town centre parking tariffs were set at a level that would encourage growth in visitor numbers and support local service users.

A public consultation on a number of council budget proposals has been carried out, and following these consultations, all parking tariffs were recommended to be changed. Those recommendations are contained within these proposals.

The proposal also includes introducing parking charges at 7 additional car parks which are currently free all day.

This is a re-advertisement of a proposal that was published on 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2017
